

When you create PDF documents from images that are compatible with Acrobat's Picture Task you will find a new toolbar/function available to you.


To demonstrate this example simply choose 'Create PDF' from the 'File' menu and then select 'From File...' in the sub-menu.



Select a picture from your hard drive using the list of available picture formats to filter these files.

When the PDF file is created Acrobat will display a dialog similar to the following.

Basically what Acrobat is telling you is that this image can now be exported and edited in another editing application all automatically!

To try this out all you have to do is display the  Tasks toolbar and select the button at the end 'Picture Tasks'.

When you select this button a drop down menu pops down displaying several menu choices, one of which is 'Export and Edit Pictures'.



When you go through this dialog your selected picture is saved to disk and then opened in your chosen Picture editing software.
